- Safety standards will be maintained by monitoring, auditing and evaluating the safety regime.

We ensure Metro Rail safety through;

- Integration of Safety Assurance in all the spheres of our business throughout all the phases of Project Life Cycle i.e. design, procurement, construction, installation, commissioning and testing, operation & maintenance and disposal.
- Provision of adequate training, instructions, information and equipment to enable the Metro Rail employee to work safely.
- Compliance to all the provisions of relevant Safety Acts, Legislations, industry standards and good practices.
- Nurturing a positive safety culture, built on mutual trust, open communication, shared values and confidence in the effectiveness of the preventive measures that empower the employees, consultants, contractors and all the other stakeholders to provide the suggestions and actively contribute towards improving the safety practices.
- Safety monitoring and regular auditing of the Metro Rail System by LTMRHL Rail Safety Management Unit.
- Complying with suggestions made by external auditors, regulatory agencies and Independent Engineer.
- Continuous improvement of safety performance through periodic review of Safety Management System and safety reports.
- Investigation of safety related events to learn lessons and put preventative measures in place.

This policy will be reviewed at-least once every year and modified as necessary.
